Let's count U.S. money in these questions!

Example: If you have 1 quarter, 2 dimes, and 1 nickel, you have $25¢ + 10¢ + 10¢ + 5¢ = 50¢$. So, you have 50¢.

(1) Sam has 3 dimes, 2 nickels, and 4 pennies. How much money does Sam have? 🌳

(2) Lily has 2 quarters and 3 dimes. How much money does she have? 🧸

(3) Tom found 1 dollar bill, 1 quarter, and 3 nickels at the zoo. How much money did he find? 🐯



(4) A small treat costs 38¢. Mark has 3 dimes and 9 pennies. Does Mark have enough money? 🍦

(5) A toy car costs 85¢. Sarah has 1 dollar bill. How much change will she get? 🚗

(6) In a piggy bank, there are 2 quarters, 3 dimes, and 4 pennies. How much money is in the bank? 🐷
