



## Mixed Word Problems: Addition and Subtraction to 20

Read the story. Decide. Solve.

Encourage using mental strategies like number bonds and counting on/back. Draw pictures if needed.

**Example:** Sarah had 8 cookies. She ate 3. How many are left?  $8 - 3 = 5$ . Answer: 5

(1) Tom had 7 toy cars. His friend gave him 9 more toy cars. How many toy cars does Tom have now? 🚗

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(2) There were 17 bananas in a basket. Sarah ate 8 of them. How many bananas are left in the basket? 🍌

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(3) A farmer had 10 sheep in a field. He bought 5 more sheep. How many sheep does the farmer have in total? 🐑

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(4) Emily had 14 crayons. She gave 6 crayons to her sister. How many crayons does Emily have now? 🖍️

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(5) David read 11 books last month. This month, he read 7 more books. How many books did David read in total over two months?



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(6) There were 19 flowers in a garden. 12 flowers wilted and were removed. How many healthy flowers are left? 🌸

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
