Read. Write a multiplication sentence to solve.

Products ≤ 25 . Examples: 4 groups of 3 $\rightarrow 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 12$ or $4 \times 3 = 12$. Keep it one step.

Example: There are 4 boxes with 3 markers in each. $4 \times 3 = 12$. Answer: 12 markers.

(1) Two birds each found 2 worms. How many worms did they find?



(2) There are 2 cars. Each car has 3 people inside. How many people are there? 



(3) A cat has 2 bowls. Each bowl has 4 fish. How many fish are there? 🐱

(4) Five children each have 2 balloons. How many balloons in all? 🎈

(5) Three friends each brought 3 apples to school. How many apples did they bring? 🍏



(6) A farmer planted 3 rows of corn. Each row has 4 corn stalks. How many corn stalks in total? 🌽

(7) There are 5 nests. Each nest has 3 eggs. How many eggs are there? 🥚

(8) Four tables each have 4 chairs around them. How many chairs are there? 🪑
