(5) A toy store had 63 toy cars. They sold 21 toy cars. How many toy cars are left? 🚗

(6) A baker made 75 cookies. He sold 30 cookies. How many cookies does he have now? 🍪



(7) A farmer had 80 chickens. 17 chickens ran into the barn. How many chickens are still outside? 🐔

(8) The library had 99 storybooks. 45 storybooks were checked out. How many storybooks are still on the shelves? 📖
