Solve Time Problems

Use 5/10/15/30-minute intervals. Show a.m./p.m. when given. Do not cross midnight.

Example: 3:00 p.m. + 30 min = 3:30 p.m. It ends at 3:30 p.m.

(1) The zoo opens at 8:30 a.m. You arrive 30 minutes later. What time do you arrive? 🐘

(2) A picnic at the park starts at 1:30 p.m. It lasts for 30 minutes. What time does the picnic end? 🧺



(3) Story time at the library begins at 10:30 a.m. It lasts 30 minutes.
What time does story time finish? 📖

(4) Your playdate starts at 3:30 p.m. You play for 30 minutes. What
time does your playdate end? 🧒

(5) Art class starts at 9:00 a.m. It is 30 minutes long. What time does
art class finish? 🎨



(6) Dinner is served at 6:00 p.m. You eat for 30 minutes. What time are you done eating? 🍴
