Read the story. Write an addition sentence.

Example: Lily had 3 apples. Tom gave her 2 more. How many apples does Lily have now? $3 + 2 = 5$. Answer: 5


(1) Emma has **8** balloons and buys **7** more at the store. How many balloons does she have now? 🎈


(2) A basket has **12** oranges and **9** lemons. How many fruits are in the basket? 🍊


(3) Carlos finds **6** rocks on the beach and then finds **8** more. How many rocks did he find altogether? 🪨


(4) A farmer has **11** chickens and gets **4** more. How many chickens does the farmer have now? 🐔




(5) There are **14** students in the library and **9** more come in. How many students are in the library now? 

(6) Maya colors **10** pictures on Saturday and **8** pictures on Sunday. How many pictures did she color in all? 

(7) A park has **15** oak trees and **6** maple trees. How many trees are in the park? 

(8) Ryan catches **9** butterflies in the morning and **5** in the afternoon. How many butterflies did he catch? 

(9) A toy store has **20** teddy bears and receives **7** more. How many teddy bears does the store have now? 



(10) Sophie bakes **13** cookies and her mom bakes **11** cookies. How many cookies did they bake together? 🍪
