Count each type of bill separately, then add all amounts together. Remember: Five-dollar bill = \$5, One-dollar bill = \$1.

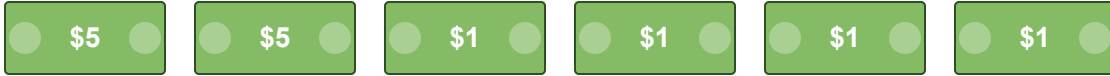
- (1) Alex has one five-dollar bill and two one-dollar bills. He finds one five-dollar bill and three one-dollar bills. How much money does Alex have now?



- (2) Mia has four one-dollar bills. Leo has one five-dollar bill and three one-dollar bills. How much money do they have together?



(3) Sarah saved two five-dollar bills. She then earned four one-dollar bills. How much money does Sarah have in total?



(4) David received one five-dollar bill and one one-dollar bill for his birthday. His aunt gave him two five-dollar bills. How much money did he get in all?



(5) Emily found six one-dollar bills in her drawer. She also found one five-dollar bill under her bed. How much money did Emily find altogether?
