Add money amounts. Show your work.

Example: Example: Tom buys a pencil for \$0.50 and an eraser for \$0.35. How much does he spend?

Answer: \$0.85 ($50\text{¢} + 35\text{¢} = 85\text{¢}$)

(1) Mia buys a small toy car for 65 cents and a sticker for 40 cents. How much money does she spend in total?

(2) Leo received 75 cents for helping his neighbor and 50 cents from his grandma. How much money does Leo have altogether?

(3) A colorful crayon costs 80 cents and a small eraser costs 35 cents. What is the total cost for both items?

(4) Lily found 90 cents in her piggy bank and earned 25 cents for doing chores. How much money does Lily have now?



(5) Tom bought a shiny apple for 55 cents and a juice box for 60 cents. How much did he spend on his snack?

(6) Emma had 45 cents in her pocket. Her dad gave her 70 cents more. How much money does Emma have in total?

(7) A small storybook costs 70 cents and a bookmark costs 80 cents. What is the combined cost for the book and bookmark?

(8) David saved 60 cents last week and 90 cents this week. How much money has David saved in all?

(9) A new pencil costs 95 cents and a small notebook costs 30 cents. How much money is needed to buy both?



(10) Sophia earned 85 cents helping her mom and 40 cents helping her dad. How much money did Sophia earn in total?
