What is the combined cost?

(6) Mark buys a t-shirt for \$23.15 and a pair of socks for \$14.90 👕 .
How much does he spend?

(7) Sarah buys a banana for \$1.29, a yogurt for \$0.85, and a small loaf of bread for \$2.75 🛒 . What is her total grocery bill?

(8) John buys dog treats for \$9.60 and a new toy for his puppy for \$7.85 🐾 . How much money does he spend?
