(5) Lily read 20 pages of her book on Monday and 17 pages on Tuesday. How many pages did she read in total? 📖

(6) A farmer planted 22 apple trees, 14 pear trees, and 11 cherry trees. How many trees did the farmer plant in total? 🌳
