Solve multi-step problems. Show work and units.

Example: Sarah had 5 apples. Her friend gave her 3 more. Then her mom bought 4 more. How many apples does Sarah have now? Answer: $5 + 3 + 4 = 12$ apples.

- (1) A baker bakes 57 cookies on Monday, 38 cookies on Tuesday, and 65 cookies on Wednesday. How many cookies did the baker bake in total? 🍪

- (2) A garden has 43 red flowers, 29 yellow flowers, and 56 blue flowers. How many flowers are in the garden altogether? 🌸

- (3) Tom collected 72 stamps. His aunt gave him 25 more stamps, and his uncle gave him 39 stamps. How many stamps does Tom have now? 📧



(4) A bus carried 36 passengers on its first trip. On the second trip, 45 new passengers got on, and on the third trip, 28 more joined. What is the total number of passengers carried? 🚌

(5) Sarah has 83 beads. She buys 47 more beads and then finds 19 beads in her craft box. How many beads does Sarah have in all? ✨

(6) A school fair sold 125 tickets on Friday, 98 tickets on Saturday, and 112 tickets on Sunday. How many tickets were sold over the weekend? 🎟️

(7) Mark read 68 pages of a book on Monday, 53 pages on Tuesday, and 71 pages on Wednesday. How many pages did he read in total?



(8) A fruit stand sold 95 apples, 67 oranges, and 88 bananas in one day. How many pieces of fruit were sold altogether? 🍏
