(2) Emma collected 94 seashells on Saturday and 68 seashells on Sunday. How many seashells does she have altogether? 🐚

(3) A zoo has 215 birds and receives 49 more birds. How many birds does the zoo have now? 🦜

(4) Marcus scored 73 points in the first game and 59 points in the second game. How many points did he score in both games? 🏀



(5) A garden has 182 red flowers and the gardener plants 37 more red flowers. How many red flowers are in the garden now? 🌸
