Solve length word problems with customary units.

12 inches = 1 foot | 3 feet = 1 yard | 1,760 yards = 1 mile

Example: Remember these conversions: • 12 inches = 1 foot • 3 feet = 1 yard • 36 inches = 1 yard

(1) A ribbon is 24 inches long. How many feet long is the ribbon? 🎀

(2) A table is 3 feet tall. How many inches tall is the table? 🪵

(3) A small rug is 6 feet long. How many yards long is the rug? 🧶

(4) A piece of fabric is 5 yards long. How many feet long is the fabric?



(5) A baby blanket is 72 inches long. How many yards long is the blanket? 🧸



(6) A jump rope is 2 yards long. How many inches long is the jump rope? 🧑🏻‍🦹

(7) A snake is 4 feet long. How many inches long is the snake? 🐍

(8) The classroom door is 7 feet tall. How many inches tall is the door?



(9) A pencil is 6 inches long. If you line up 2 pencils, how many feet long are they together? 🖋️

(10) A fence post is 3 yards tall. How many feet tall is the fence post? 🚧
