Fill in the missing hundreds, tens, or ones.

Tip: Match each expanded-form part to its place: hundreds (x00), tens (x0), ones. If the number is 246, the parts are $200 + 40 + 6$.

Example: $200 + \underline{\quad} + 7 = 257 \rightarrow$ tens = 50

(1) $\underline{\quad} + 30 + 2 = 532$

(2) $\underline{\quad} + 50 + 7 = 157$

(3) $\underline{\quad} + 0 + 5 = 805$

(4) $\underline{\quad} + 50 + 0 = 450$

(5) $200 + \underline{\quad} + 8 = 258$

(6) $600 + \underline{\quad} + 5 = 615$
