Read. Solve the story problems.

Example: Mia has 7 apples. She gives 3 apples to Tom. How many apples does Mia have left? $7 - 3 = 4$. Answer: 4

- (1) Emma had 32 stickers. She used 15 on her notebook and then received 11 more from her sister. How many stickers does she have now? 🎨

- (2) A basket had 41 apples. 19 apples were sold at the market. Then 7 more apples were added. How many apples are in the basket now?



- (3) Jake collected 26 rocks on Monday and 18 rocks on Tuesday. He gave 13 rocks to his friend. How many rocks does he have now? 🪨



(4) There were 55 balloons at the party. 22 balloons popped and then 16 new balloons were brought in. How many balloons are there now? 🎈

(5) A library had 38 books on a shelf. 14 books were checked out. Then 20 books were returned. How many books are on the shelf now? 📖
