Subtract to find change or remaining amount.

Example: Example: Anna has \$10.00. She spends \$7.50 on a book. How much does she have left?

Answer: \$2.50 ($\$10.00 - \$7.50 = \2.50)

(1) Lily has \$5.00. She buys a toy car for \$1.80. How much money does she have left?

(2) David has \$10.00. He buys a book for \$4.15. How much change does he receive?

(3) Maria has \$15.00. She buys art supplies for \$6.60. How much money does she have left?

(4) John has \$20.00. He buys a new game for \$11.30. How much change does he get?



(5) Emily has \$7.00. She buys a small plant for \$3.45. How much money does she have left?

(6) Sam has \$12.00. He buys a comic book for \$9.75. How much change does he receive?

(7) Sarah has \$8.00. She buys a packet of stickers for \$2.90. How much money does she have left?

(8) Michael has \$11.00. He buys a new pen for \$5.35. How much change does he get?

(9) Anna has \$6.00. She buys a small snack for \$4.80. How much money does she have left?



(10) Chris has \$13.00. He buys a toy car for \$7.10. How much change does he receive?
