Solve each word problem using multiplication.

Example: A spider has 8 legs. How many legs do 4 spiders have? Answer: $4 \times 8 = 32$ legs

- (1) There are 8 monkeys at the zoo. Each monkey eats 4 bananas. How many bananas do they eat in total? 🐒

- (2) A farmer has 5 ducks. Each duck lays 2 eggs a day. How many eggs do the ducks lay in one day? 🦆

- (3) The pet store has 10 cats. Each cat needs 5 toys. How many toys are needed for all the cats? 🐱

- (4) At the zoo, there are 3 giraffes. Each giraffe eats 9 bundles of leaves. How many bundles of leaves do they eat? 🦒



(5) There are 6 pigs on the farm. Each pig rolls in 3 mud puddles every morning. How many mud puddles do they roll in? 🐷

(6) A pet owner has 7 hamsters. Each hamster needs 2 water bottles. How many water bottles are needed? 🐹
