(3) A backpack weighs 12 pounds and a suitcase weighs 18 pounds. Which item is heavier?

(4) A box of crayons weighs 6 ounces and a pencil case weighs 9 ounces. Which item is lighter?



(5) A small dog weighs 10 pounds. How many ounces does the dog weigh?

(6) A stack of books weighs 96 ounces. How many pounds does the stack weigh?

(7) A large book weighs 4 pounds and a small book weighs 2 pounds. What is their total weight?

(8) A bag of grapes weighs 20 ounces. You eat 5 ounces. How many ounces are left?

(9) A small box weighs 1 pound. A toy car weighs 14 ounces. Which item is heavier?



(10) A bag of rice weighs 34 ounces. A bag of beans weighs 2 pounds.
Which bag is lighter?
