



## Subtraction Word Problems (1–2 digits)

Grade 2

Look for "how many left?" or "how many more?". Subtract the smaller number from the bigger one. **Example:**

Question: Ben had 35 marbles. He gave 8 to a friend. How many marbles does Ben have left? Solution:  $35 - 8 = 27$ . Ben has 27 marbles left.

- (1) Sarah picked 35 flowers. She gave 12 flowers to her mom. How many flowers does Sarah have left? 🌸
- 
- (2) There were 58 cars in a parking lot. 23 cars drove away. How many cars are still in the parking lot? 🚗
- 
- (3) Mom baked 47 cookies. The children ate 14 cookies. How many cookies are left? 🍪

(4) Tom had 61 marbles. He lost 25 marbles while playing. How many marbles does Tom have now? ●
