Example: There were 12 apples. 5 apples were eaten. How many are left? Equation: $12 - 5 = 7$. Answer: 7.

How many cookies are left? 🍪

(2) A toy store had 412 toy cars on display. They sold 195 toy cars during the week. How many toy cars are left? 🚗

(3) Sarah is reading a book with 587 pages. She has already read 249 pages. How many pages does she have left to read? 📖

(4) There were 763 birds at a nature sanctuary. During a migration, 327 birds flew away. How many birds are still in the sanctuary? 🐦



(5) Mark had 291 stickers in his collection. He gave 136 stickers to his friends. How many stickers does Mark have now? ✨
