Example: Sarah had 25 stickers. She bought 12 more. How many stickers does Sarah have now? Answer: 37

(1) A toy store received 36 new toy cars and 47 new toy planes. How many new toys did the store receive in total? 🚗

(2) A class had 81 library books. Students returned 35 books. How many library books are still out? 📖

(3) Maria picked 23 strawberries and then picked 56 more. How many strawberries did Maria pick altogether? 🍓

(4) There were 78 birds on a tree. 24 birds flew away. How many birds are left on the tree? 🐦



(5) David saved \$59 last month and \$34 this month. How much money has David saved in total? 💰

(6) A baker made 93 cookies. He sold 48 cookies in the morning. How many cookies does he have left? 🍪
