- (1) A baker bakes 35 cookies in the morning and 42 cookies in the afternoon. How many cookies did she bake altogether? 🍪

- (2) Lily has 28 red marbles and 51 blue marbles. How many marbles does she have in total? 🎲

- (3) A bus picked up 19 passengers at the first stop and 37 passengers at the second stop. How many passengers are on the bus? 🚌

- (4) There are 63 birds on a tree. 25 more birds fly to the tree. How many birds are on the tree now? 🐦

- (5) Mark saved 45 dollars in May and 30 dollars in June. How much money did Mark save in total? 💰



(6) A flower shop sold 74 roses on Saturday and 18 roses on Sunday. How many roses were sold over the weekend? 🌸

(7) David read 23 pages of a book on Tuesday and 64 pages on Wednesday. How many pages did he read in all? 📖

(8) A farmer planted 50 apple trees and 38 pear trees. How many fruit trees did the farmer plant? 🌳
