




## Addition Word Problems: Multi-Step - Set A

Solve multi-step problems. Show work and units.

**Example:** Sarah had 5 apples. Her friend gave her 3 more. Then her mom bought 4 more. How many apples does Sarah have now? Answer:  $5 + 3 + 4 = 12$  apples.


- (1) A small library had 137 storybooks. They received 89 new books last week and 75 more books this week. How many storybooks does the library have now? 

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- (2) A farmer had 218 chickens. He bought 63 more chickens from a neighbor and then 59 more at the market. How many chickens does the farmer have in total?



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- (3) Ben had 54 toy cars. His aunt gave him 37 new cars for his birthday, and he bought 26 more with his allowance. How many toy cars does Ben own now? 

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- (4) On Saturday, 145 people visited the museum in the morning, 98 people visited in the afternoon, and 67 people visited in the evening. What was the total number of visitors that day? 

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(5) Sarah saved \$73 in April, \$58 in May, and \$49 in June. How much money did Sarah save altogether during these three months? 💰

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(6) A stationery shop had 329 pencils. They received a delivery of 105 pencils on Tuesday and another 88 pencils on Friday. How many pencils does the shop have now? 🖋️

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(7) In a fruit basket, there were 112 apples, 97 oranges, and 85 bananas. How many pieces of fruit are there in the basket altogether? 🍎

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(8) Northwood School has 153 students in Grade 1, 147 students in Grade 2, and 165 students in Grade 3. What is the total number of students in these three grades? 🏫

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
