



## Dividing into Equal Groups: Making Groups – Grade 3 (Medium) – Set 1

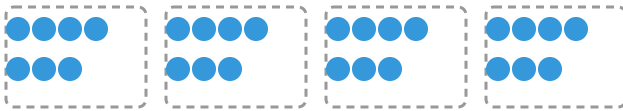

**Example:** Count the objects shown. Divide them into the given number of equal groups. Find how many in each group.

- (1) 28 toy cars are parked equally into 4 garages. How many toy cars are in each garage?



- (2) 30 balloons are tied equally onto 5 gift boxes. How many balloons are on each gift box?

- (3) 40 pencils are shared equally among 8 students. How many pencils does each student get?

- (4) 27 butterflies are divided equally into 3 nets. How many butterflies are in each net?



(5) 24 oranges are placed equally into 6 fruit bowls. How many oranges are in each fruit bowl?

(6) 35 coins are sorted equally into 7 piggy banks. How many coins are in each piggy bank?

(7) 42 stamps are put equally onto 6 envelopes. How many stamps are on each envelope?
