Solve division word problems. Show your work.

Example: Maria has 15 apples. She puts them into 5 baskets equally. How many apples are in each basket? $15 \div 5 = 3$ apples

- (1) Sarah has 48 stickers. She wants to share them equally among 6 friends. How many stickers does each friend get? ✨

- (2) A baker made 63 cupcakes. He needs to put them into 7 boxes with an equal number in each box. How many cupcakes are in each box? 🍰

- (3) There are 72 books to be arranged equally on 8 shelves. How many books will be on each shelf? 📖

- (4) Mark collected 90 stamps. He wants to put them into 9 albums, with the same number of stamps in each. How many stamps will be in each album? 📄



(5) A gardener planted 60 flowers in 10 equal rows. How many flowers are in each row? 🌸

(6) Maria has 56 beads. She uses them to make 7 identical bracelets. How many beads are on each bracelet? 🧵

(7) A class of 42 students is divided into 6 equal teams for a game. How many students are on each team? 👥

(8) Grandma baked 81 cookies and wants to share them equally among her 9 grandchildren. How many cookies does each grandchild get? 🍪
