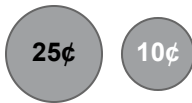

**Example:**  $\$20.00 - \$12.50 = \underline{\$7.50}$

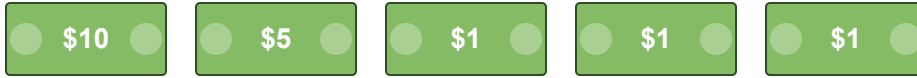
- (1) A pencil costs 25 cents. A sticker costs 10 cents. How much do they cost together? 



- (2) Sarah bought a juice box for 75 cents and a cookie for 50 cents. How much did she spend in total? 

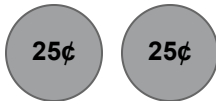


(3) A book costs 8 dollars. A game costs 10 dollars. How much do they cost together? 📖

(4) You have 90 cents. You spend 40 cents on a bouncy ball. How many cents do you have left? 🏀

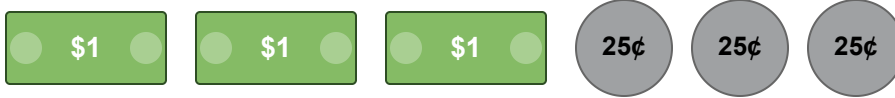

(6) Emily has 2 dollars and 50 cents. Her grandma gives her 1 dollar and 25 cents. How much money does Emily have now? 🤖



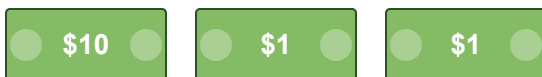
