Solve each word problem using multiplication.

Example: A spider has 8 legs. How many legs do 4 spiders have? Answer: $4 \times 8 = 32$ legs

(1) At the zoo, there are 7 enclosures. Each enclosure has 8 monkeys. How many monkeys are there in total? 🐒

(2) A farmer has 9 pigs. Each pig has 4 legs. How many pig legs are there altogether? 🐷

(3) The pet store has 6 bird feeders. Each feeder can hold 10 birds. How many birds can all the feeders hold? 🐦

(4) The zoo keeper prepares food for 8 giraffes. Each giraffe eats 5 bales of hay a day. How many bales of hay are eaten daily? 🦒

(5) On the farm, there are 10 pens. Each pen has 3 goats. How many goats are there in all? 🐐



(6) A cat has 2 ears. How many ears do 7 cats have in total? 🐱
