Read, multiply, and solve each word problem.

Example: There are 3 bags. Each bag has 4 oranges. How many oranges in total? Answer: $3 \times 4 = 12$ oranges

(1) A bird has 2 wings. How many wings do 3 birds have? 🦜

(2) There are 4 shelves. Each shelf holds 5 books. How many books are there in total? 📖

(3) A baker bakes 3 cakes every hour. How many cakes does he bake in 4 hours? 🍰

(4) Each student needs 5 sheets of paper. If there are 2 students, how many sheets are needed? 📄

(5) A dog has 4 legs. How many legs do 2 dogs have? 🐕



(6) A garden has 5 rows of sunflowers. Each row has 3 sunflowers. How many sunflowers are there? 🌻

(7) There are 3 groups of children. Each group has 2 children. How many children are there in all? 👧 👦

(8) A box of crayons has 4 different colors. If you buy 3 boxes, how many different colors do you have? 🖍️

(9) Each car has 5 seats. How many seats are there in 2 cars? 🚗

(10) A farmer plants 5 apple trees in each row. If there are 4 rows, how many apple trees are there? 🍏
