Example: A spider has 8 legs. How many legs do 7 spiders have? Answer: $7 \times 8 = 56$ legs

(1) A librarian arranged 7 shelves, placing 8 books on each shelf. How many books did the librarian arrange in total? 

(2) For a school project, students were divided into 9 groups. If each group had 6 students, how many students were there in total? 

(3) A florist made 8 bouquets of flowers. Each bouquet had 7 flowers. How many flowers did the florist use? 

(4) David bought 6 packs of trading cards. Each pack contained 9 cards. How many trading cards did David buy? 

(5) For the school play, the auditorium had 7 rows of chairs. Each row could seat 9 people. How many chairs were there? 



(6) A farmer picked apples and put them into 9 bags. If each bag held 8 apples, how many apples did the farmer pick? 🍏
