- (3) Sarah bought a juice for \$1.50, a snack for \$2.75, and a fruit for \$0.80. What was her total bill _____ ?



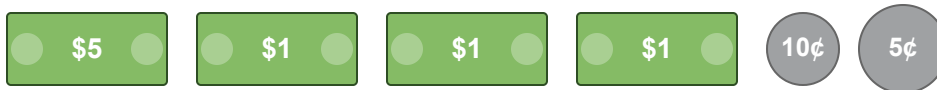

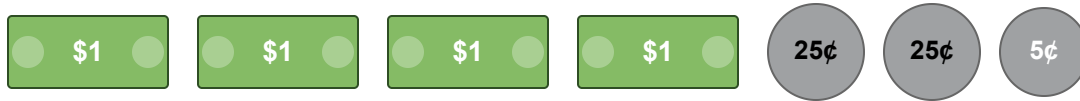
(5) You buy a small gift for \$7.10 and wrapping paper for \$2.90. What is the total cost _____ ?
