Solve Time Problems

Use 5/10/15/30-minute intervals. Show a.m./p.m. when given. Do not cross midnight. **Example:** 3:00 p.m. + 30 min = 3:30 p.m. It ends at 3:30 p.m.

(1) A movie begins at 3:30 p.m. It plays for 30 minutes. What time will the movie end? 🎬

(2) Sarah starts her homework at 5:30 p.m. She works for 30 minutes. What time does she finish? 📖

(3) The school bell rings at 9:00 a.m., which is 30 minutes after class started. What time did class begin? 🔔



(4) A baking session finished at 11:30 a.m. It lasted for 30 minutes.
What time did the baking start? 🍪

(5) A bus left the station at 7:30 a.m. and arrived at the next stop at
8:00 a.m. How long was the bus ride? 🚌

(6) The library opened at 10:00 a.m. and closed its doors for a break
at 10:30 a.m. How long was the library open before the break? 📖
