- (4) Lily had 34 stickers. Her friend gave her 46 more stickers. How many stickers does Lily have now? ✨

- (5) A baker made 14 chocolate chip cookies and 75 oatmeal cookies. How many cookies did the baker make? 🍪



(6) A teacher had 64 pencils. She bought 29 more pencils. How many pencils does the teacher have in all? 🖋️

(7) Sam collected 48 blue marbles and 31 green marbles. What is the total number of marbles he collected? 🟦

(8) In a garden, there are 24 red flowers and 67 yellow flowers. How many flowers are there altogether? 🌸
