



## Addition Word Problems: Multi-Step - Set A

Solve multi-step problems. Show work and units.

**Example:** Sarah had 5 apples. Her friend gave her 3 more. Then her mom bought 4 more. How many apples does Sarah have now? Answer:  $5 + 3 + 4 = 12$  apples.

- (1) A school library had 1,245 books. They received 876 new books in the fall and 1,052 more books in the spring. How many books does the library have now?



- (2) On Friday, 3,480 people attended a concert. On Saturday, 2,955 more people came, and on Sunday, another 1,870 people attended. What was the total attendance for the three days? 🎵

- (3) Sarah had \$1,575 in her savings account. She deposited \$890 last month and \$1,230 this month. How much money does Sarah have in her account now? 💰

- (4) Mark had 2,150 stickers. He bought 1,385 new stickers and received 975 stickers as a gift. How many stickers does Mark have in total? ✨



(5) A family drove 450 miles on the first day of their trip. On the second day, they drove 685 miles, and on the third day, they drove 590 miles. What was the total distance they traveled? 🚗

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(6) An animal sanctuary had 850 rescued animals. They took in 375 more animals last month and 420 animals this month. How many animals are in the sanctuary now? 🐾

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(7) A farm harvested 2,300 apples in the morning. In the afternoon, they harvested 1,850 more apples, and the next day, they harvested 2,100 apples. How many apples were harvested in total? 🍏

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(8) On Saturday, 1,780 people visited the museum. On Sunday, 2,150 people visited, and on Monday, another 950 people came. How many visitors did the museum have over these three days? 🏛️

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
