



## Dividing into Equal Groups: Making Groups – Grade 4 (Medium) – Set 1

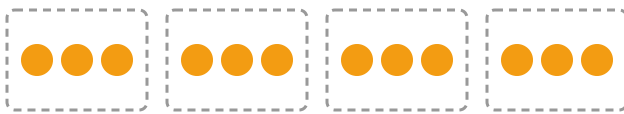

Divide objects into equal groups. Count items per group.

**Example:** Count the objects shown. Divide them into the given number of equal groups. Find how many in each group.

- (1) 28 oranges are placed equally into 4 fruit bowls. How many oranges are in each fruit bowl?



- (2) 30 pencils are distributed equally among 5 students. How many pencils does each student receive?

- (3) 45 stickers are arranged equally on 9 pages. How many stickers are on each page?

- (4) 32 toy cars are stored equally in 8 boxes. How many toy cars are in each box?



(5) 24 books are stacked equally on 6 shelves. How many books are on each shelf?

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(6) 40 balloons are tied equally into 10 bunches. How many balloons are in each bunch?

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(7) 27 cookies are divided equally among 3 friends. How many cookies does each friend get?

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(8) 36 flowers are arranged equally into 4 bouquets. How many flowers are in each bouquet?

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
