Subtract to find change or remaining amount.

Example: Example: Anna has \$10.00. She spends \$7.50 on a book. How much does she have left?

Answer: \$2.50 ($\$10.00 - \$7.50 = \2.50)

(1) Sarah had \$10.00. She bought a toy for \$3.85. How much money does Sarah have left?

(2) Mark paid \$5.00 for a candy bar that cost \$1.67. How much change should Mark receive?

(3) Emily had \$20.00. She purchased a new book for \$11.49. How much money does Emily have remaining?

(4) David had \$15.00. He spent \$7.18 on art supplies. How much money did David have left?

(5) A grocery store customer paid \$10.00 for an apple that cost \$4.92. What was their change?



(6) Jessica bought a pencil for \$2.33 and paid with a \$5.00 bill. How much change did she get?

(7) Michael had \$20.00 in his wallet. He spent \$14.55 on movie tickets. How much money does he have now?

(8) Sophia had \$10.00. She bought a small gift for \$6.05. How much money is left?

(9) A customer paid \$15.00 for an ice cream cone that cost \$8.79. How much change did they receive?

(10) Daniel had \$5.00. He bought a sticker for \$0.99. How much money does Daniel have left?
