Solve money and shopping word problems using multiplication.

Example: A pencil costs \$2. How much do 5 pencils cost? Answer: $5 \times \$2 = \10

- (1) A bag of apples costs \$2. Sarah buys 8 bags of apples. How much does she spend in total? 🍏

\$10 \$5 \$1

- (2) Each pencil costs \$4. If a student buys 6 pencils, what is the total cost? ✎

\$20 1¢ 1¢ 1¢ 1¢

- (3) A bookstore sells novels for \$7 each. Mark buys 5 novels. How much money does he need? 📖

\$20 \$10 \$5



(4) Tickets to the fair cost \$9 each. A family buys 3 tickets. What is their total expense? 🎫



(5) A pack of gum costs \$3. If you buy 10 packs, how much will you pay? 🍬



(6) Each small toy car costs \$6. If a collector purchases 7 toy cars, what is the grand total? 🚗
