Order numerals from least to greatest.

I = 1 V = 5 X = 10 L = 50 C = 100 D = 500 M = 1,000

Example: V, XIV, III, X → III, V, X, XIV

(1) Order from least to greatest: XXXII, LXII, XLVI, XV

(2) Order from least to greatest: LXII, LXXIII, LXX, XLII

(3) Order from least to greatest: LIX, LXXII, LXXI, XXXVI

(4) Order from least to greatest: XXXVII, LI, XLVIII, XVII

(5) Order from least to greatest: XXXVII, LXV, XLVIII, XII

(6) Order from least to greatest: XLI, LXVIII, LXIV, XIX
