Example: Sarah has 8 apples. Tom has 3 apples. How many more apples does Sarah have than Tom? Answer: 5 apples.

- (1) The main city library has 12,580 books. The branch library has 9,345 books. What is the difference in the number of books between the two libraries? 📖

- (2) An adult elephant can weigh up to 7,200 kilograms. A large rhinoceros can weigh up to 4,850 kilograms. How much more does the elephant weigh than the rhinoceros? 🐘

- (3) Sarah saved \$9,500 for a new car. Mark saved \$7,825 for a down payment on a house. How much more money did Sarah save than Mark? 💰

- (4) The distance from City X to City Y is 1,875 miles. The distance from City X to City Z is 1,230 miles. How many fewer miles is it to City Z than to City Y from City X? 📖

(5) A popular museum had 23,450 visitors in April and 18,990 visitors in May. How many more visitors did the museum have in April than in May? 🏛️

(6) A toy factory produced 45,670 toy cars in November and 38,125 toy cars in December. What is the difference in the number of toy cars produced between the two months? 🚗

(7) Emily has a stamp collection of 5,120 stamps. Her brother, David, has 3,985 stamps. How many more stamps does Emily have than David? 📧

(8) In a video game, Player A scored 1,560 points and Player B scored 985 points. How many fewer points did Player B score than Player A? 🎮
