



## Convert Customary Capacity

Convert between customary capacity units.

Use the conversion factors: 1 Gallon (gal) = 4 Quarts (qt), 1 Quart (qt) = 2 Pints (pt), 1 Pint (pt) = 2 Cups (c).

**Example:** 2 qt = 4 pt
