Order numerals from least to greatest.

I = 1 V = 5 X = 10 L = 50 C = 100 D = 500 M = 1,000

Example: V, XIV, III, X → III, V, X, XIV

(1) Order from least to greatest: LIII, CXX, LXXXIV, XXXV

(2) Order from least to greatest: LXXX, C, LXXXVII, XXIII

(3) Order from least to greatest: XLI, LXXX, XLII, XXXIX

(4) Order from least to greatest: LXXVII, CXIV, CXII, XIX

(5) Order from least to greatest: XCI, CXIII, CX, LXXX

(6) Order from least to greatest: LX, CV, LXXII, LV
