Fill in the blank with I or me.

Use **I** when the pronoun is the *subject* — the one doing the action.

Use **me** when the pronoun is the *object* — the one receiving the action or coming after a preposition.

*Tip: Remove the other person's name and try each alone — trust your ear!*
