**Adjective** → describes a *noun* · **Adverb** → describes a *verb* **TIP** Words like **fast** and **hard** can be both – check the sentence context!

**Example:** loud → (A) **Adjective** (a loud alarm) · loudly → (B) **Adverb** (he yelled loudly)
