Complete the sentence with the correct possessive pronoun.

Possessive pronouns show ownership and **stand alone** — no noun follows them.

Use: **mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs.**

Tip: Do **NOT** add an apostrophe. "It's" means "it is" — never use it for ownership.

Example: That toy belongs to me. It is \_\_\_\_\_. → **mine**
