Dog vs Wolf: Wild Cousins



Dogs and wolves are very much alike! They **both** belong to the same animal family and look similar with their fur, pointy ears, and tails. They also **both** communicate using howls, barks, and growls.

However, dogs and wolves live very different lives. Dogs often live with humans as pets, enjoying warm beds and food bowls. **Unlike** dogs, wolves are wild animals that live in forests and mountains. They hunt for their own food and live in packs.

Dogs come in many shapes and sizes, from tiny chihuahuas to big great Danes. **While** dogs love to play fetch, wolves are usually shy around people and prefer to stay hidden. Wolves have a very strong sense of smell to track prey, which is super important for their survival in the wild.
