Identify the prepositional phrase. Then write whether it acts as an ****adjective phrase**** (describing a noun) or an ****adverb phrase**** (describing a verb).

Adverb phrase → modifies a verb: "She sat *by the window*." (tells where she sat)

Adjective phrase → modifies a noun: "The girl *by the window* waved." (tells which girl)

Example: 🚗 He drove through the tunnel. → **adverb phrase** (tells where he drove)
