- A** Areas where the soil is saturated with water, providing important ecosystem services like water filtration.
- B** Features permafrost, treeless landscapes, and extremely cold temperatures.
- C** The largest biome on Earth, characterized by saltwater and vast aquatic biodiversity.
- D** Characterized by high biodiversity and a distinct canopy layer.
- E** Dominated by coniferous trees, experiencing long, cold winters and short, mild summers.
- F** Receives less than 25 centimeters of rainfall annually, with extreme daily temperature shifts.
